Commemorative note available as of 1 June 2017



A Commemorative \$10 Bank Note

On 7 April 2017, the Bank of Canada unveiled a commemorative \$10 bank note to celebrate Canada's 150th anniversary of Confederation.

The **Canada 150 bank note** celebrates Confederation with a unique design depicting our history, land and culture. This commemorative note will be available to Canadians through financial institutions starting 1 June and will circulate along with the existing \$10 note.

This commemorative note has some new **security features** and others that are similar to the features on the current *Polymer series* notes. These features make the note easy to check and difficult to counterfeit.

Visit the Bank's website for **tools** to help you recognize this historic addition to Canada's currency.

Produced in limited quantity, commemorative notes are designed to mark historic milestones. Since this commemorative note will be issued in relatively small numbers and may be retained by Canadians, its volume and time in circulation may be limited.
